## VP8 – SOUTH GEORGIA

The Braveheart anchored off the shores of South Georgia late last week, however the team got delayed because of the weather conditions. They fired up today just after 0000Z as VP8GEO. Plans are to be QRV for up to 10 days on all bands from 10 to 160 meters on CW, SSB and RTTY. Team members include 9V1YC, EI5IQ, EI6FR, HB9ASZ, K0IR, K4UEE, K5TR, N5KO, PA3FQA, VE3EJ, W3WL and W7EW. South Georgia ranks # 10 on The DX Magazine's Most Wanted List and # 13 on the 425 DX News Most Wanted List. Suggested frequencies are as follows: **CW** – 3510, 7003, 7023, 10105, 14024, 18072, 21024, 24894 and 28024; **RTTY** – 21082; **SSB** – 14195, 18135, 21295, 24935 and 28495. Remember there is no web page or on-line logs for this operation. Carl, N4AA, of QRZ DX reports that Bob, K4UEE, will be presenting the VP8 DXpedition at the Charlotte Hamfest, the weekend of March 9-10. QSL cards go via VE3GCO (VE3XN), Garry V. ## P5 – NORTH KOREA

Ed, P5/4L4FN, is back in Pyongyang, North Korea after a vacation at home in Georgia, former Soviet republic.



He has assembled and installed his new Butternut vertical and has been using it mostly on 15 meters SSB. Look for him on 21225 listening from 2230 to 2330Z during weekdays. Ed hopes to have his accreditation completed in the next week or so. QSL via KK5DO.

## 9Q – DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC OF CONGO

With the recent volcano activity in Goma, Democratic Republic of Congo don't be surprised to see some Amateur Radio activity. After failure of radio-telecom systems between Goma and Kinshasa, the ARAC has been invited to set up an emergency HF link between the 2 areas. The IARU society's proposals have been given to the Ministry of PTT, which would include four permanent ham radio licenses to be issued. Patrick, 9Q/F6BLQ, says to look for some contest activity during the CQ WPX SSB Contest at the end of March.

## VP8 – SOUTH SHETLANDS

Oleg, UA1PBA, is a commander of the Russian Antarctic base Bellingshausen, King George Island, South Shetlands. He is the operator of club station R1ANF and can be found on 21275 at 1700Z. ## DXCC NEWS

Effective immediately the ARRL DXCC Desk will no longer accept unauthorized QSL cards from DX stations being managed by Michel Hamoniaux, PY3ZM/F (ex HH2HM, OK8ZM). In order for any Hamoniaux QSL cards to be accepted by the ARRL he must first have the DX station send an authorization letter to the DXCC Desk. This QSL manager has been under investigation for some time now and this is not the first time the ARRL has not accepted his QSLs. Omar, YK1AO, reports he does not have a QSL manger and that includes PY3ZM! Otto, HC2DX, is currently QRV and giving PY3ZM as his QSL manager. These QSL cards will not be accepted from PY3ZM until Otto sends an authorization letter to the DXCC Desk.

- **4W – East Timor** – Thor, 4W6MM, will be leaving at the end of this month for three weeks in Italy.
- **5H – Tanzania** – Maurizio, IK2GZU, will be back in 5H, Tanzania, for an operation February 5-27, CW and phone during his free time. He'll be given the callsign upon arrival. He hopes to be active in the ARRL CW event February 16-17. QSL to his home call.
- **C6A – Bahamas** – Gary, KI6T, will be on as C6AGS from February 12-17, SSB and CW, 10-40. He will be on IOTA NA-80 and will be active in the ARRL DX contest.
- **C6A – Bahamas** – Bill, K1CN, expects to be QRV as C6AWW from Harbour Island, Bahamas during the ARRL CW DX Contest and for a few hours in the ARRL SSB DX Contest. Look for activity on 10-40 meters CW and SSB between February 15 and March 1. QSL via K1CN.

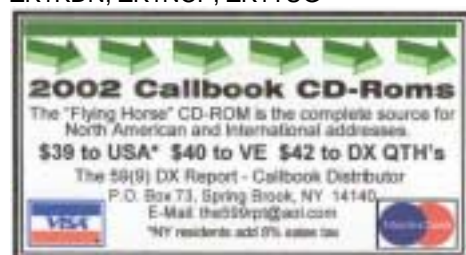
